

ENDORSEMENT: YES on Prop 11

Dear Voters,

We have united our voices in support of Proposition 11. For 20 years we represented the Alpine, Highland, and Cedar Hills communities as your elected officials on the Alpine School District Board of Education. Being entrusted with decisions regarding the education of our children is a very great responsibility, and one that none of us took lightly.

Proposition 11 will be on the ballot Nov. 5. The Proposition asks voters if they would like to split Alpine School District. There have been multiple studies, public hearings, and long discussions regarding this topic. Over the summer, six municipalities- Lehi, American Fork, Highland, Alpine, Cedar Hills and the Suncrest portion of Draper- worked through an interlocal agreement and voted unanimously to move forward with a proposal to form their own school district. The next step is for our citizens to vote.

We have differing views on many political and educational issues. However, having worked behind the scenes for 20 years advocating for the Lone Peak High School area, we are united in support of the proposal to split Alpine School District.
